

# Application deadline extended for Sandy housing recovery programs

The Christie administration announced it is extending the application deadline for its new housing recovery programs.

Eligible low- to moderate-income (LMI) householders now have until March 20th to apply for the LMI Homeowners Rebuilding Program and April 6th to apply for the Tenant-Based Rental Assistance Program, the Department of Community Affairs said in a news release.

The initial application deadline for the LMI Homeowners Rebuilding Program and TBRA Program had been March 4, the DCA said.

The LMI Homeowners Rebuilding Program provides reconstruction, rehabilitation and elevation assistance to Hurricane Sandy-impacted homeowners of limited financial means whose storm-damaged primary residence is located in one of the nine most impacted counties as determined by the federal government, the DCA said.

The TBRA Program provides short-term, tenant-based rental assistance in the form of a voucher to assist eligible low- and moderate-income households with their rent in the nine counties most impacted by Hurricane Sandy, the DCA said.
