

Workshop for Sandy victims unsatisfied with flood claims

A free workshop for victims of Hurricane Sandy who are not satisfied with their flood insurance claim settlements will be held at 5 p.m. July 15 at the Brigantine Community Center, 265 42nd St. in Brigantine.

The event is coordinated by Volunteer Lawyers for Justice, Brigstrong, the Ocean County Long Term Recovery Group and Legal Services of New Jersey.

Homeowners who filed a flood insurance claim after Sandy and are not satisfied with the amount of money they received from their insurance company, can request a review of their claim through the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

The workshop will explain how homeowners can file the claim themselves without hiring an adjuster or legal firm. Attorneys will explain the National Flood Insurance Program claims-review process, answer questions and conduct intakes to see if participants might be eligible for continued free legal services.
